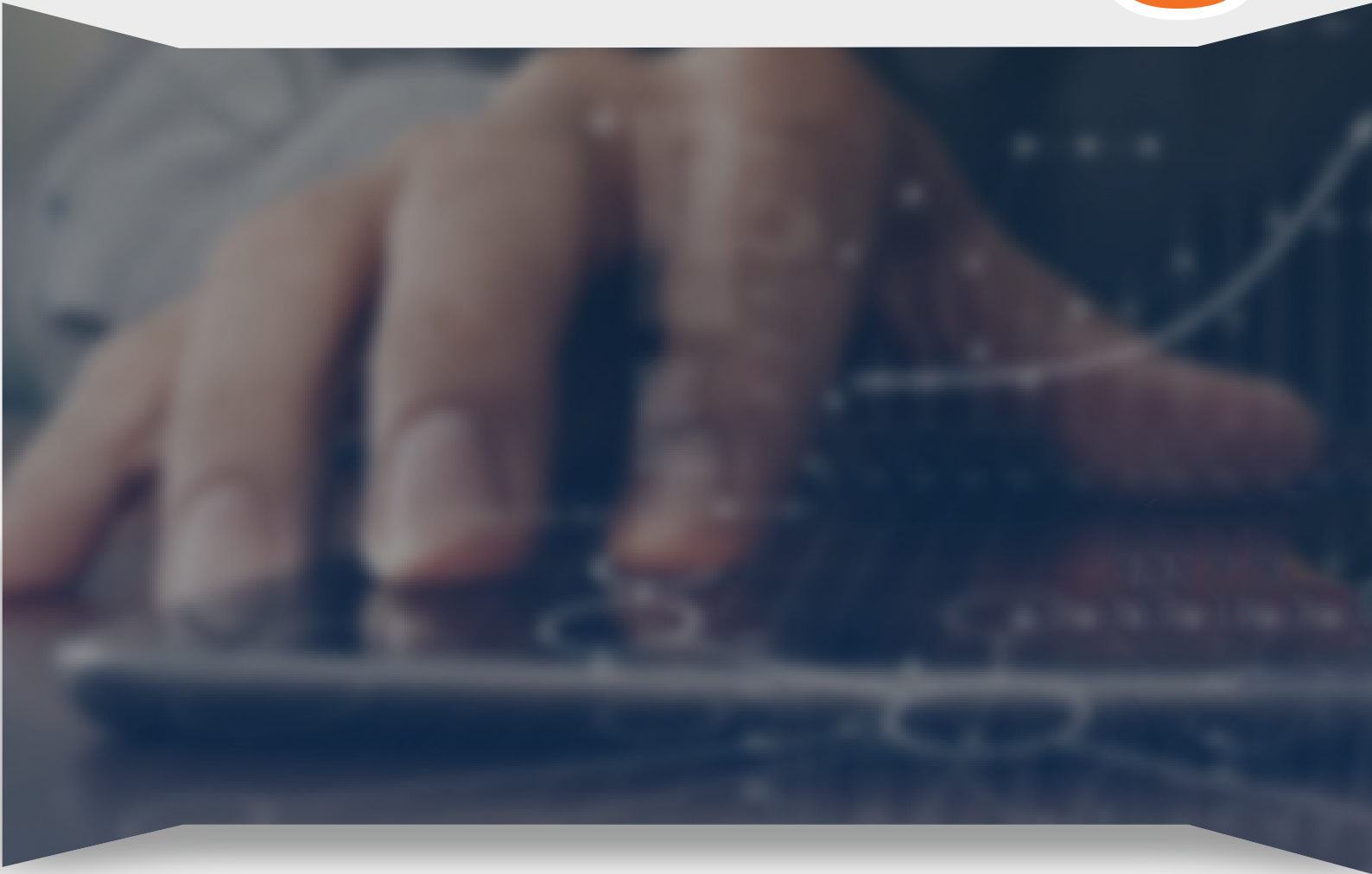

## IBPS PO Interview

After clearing the pre and the mains exam, the candidates are called for a face-to-face interview which is of 100 marks.

The minimum qualifying marks in the interview is 40% (35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates).
